Position Title - Industrial Firefighter / Rescuer

Employment Status - Part Time, Term employment

Duties Summary -

The Industrial Firefighter / Rescuer is essential at many high-risk work locations. During industrial expansions, turnarounds or projects, our staff shall focus on the personal safety of any people working on the client's worksite. We shall provide industrial rescue and medical services around the clock when required.

Example of Essential Duties –

Staff assigned to Fire and Rescue teams while working for Elite Safety Services, shall be responsible for:

1. Performing fire suppression activities at the scene of an emergency. This includes fire prevention and inspection activities, equipment checks and refresher training to ensure readiness.
2. Administering first aid or emergency medical care to sick and injured workers, including defibrillation.
3. Assisting with any rescues which involve sick or injured workers.
4. Completing applicable documentation while on site.

Minimum Qualifications

- NPFA 1001 or NFPA 1081 certification. Some consideration will be given to former certifications attained through the Manitoba Emergency Services College.
- Incident Command
- Site-specific orientations

*** Any required training needed by staff will be provided by Elite Safety Services prior to work commencing at no cost, prior to work commencing.



Please Note:

All staff working for Elite Safety Services will be covered by our General Liability insurance policies and Manitoba WCB during assigned work. With the exception of steel toe boots, all Personal Protective Equipment will be provided free of charge.

Staff may be required to travel for extended periods of up to two weeks.
